We study the outsourcing of low-skilled service tasks (cleaning, catering and security) with French matched employer-employee data from the period 2001-2019. In line with the literature, we find a substantial penalty in the earnings of the outsourced employees, that persists 7 years after treatment. In contrast to the literature, we find that it is entirely explained by a fall in hours. Interviews with various stakeholders in these industries indicate that cutting the hours on a given site is a common way to compete on prices for subcontractor firms, and that the decline in hours results in both work intensification and a decrease in quality.
